Individuals who should attend:

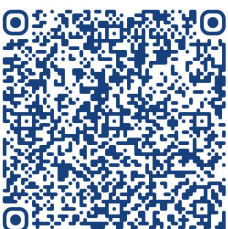
- People Receiving a Social Security Disability Benefit and Interested in Work
